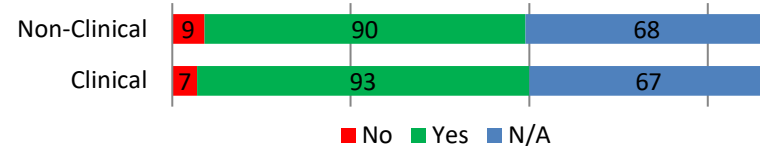

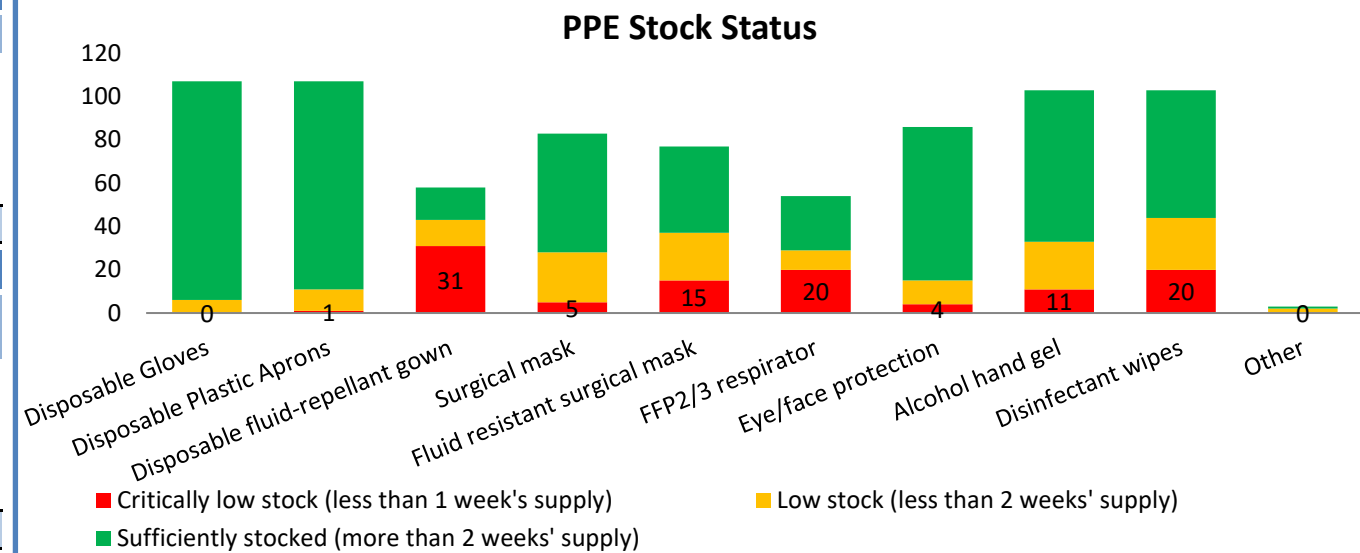
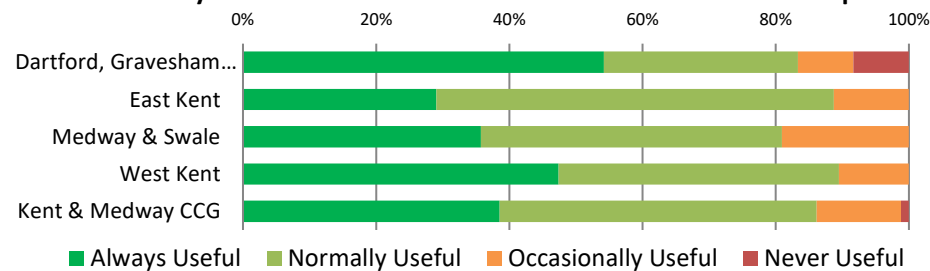

How useful do you find the information included in the GP COVID-19 Update?

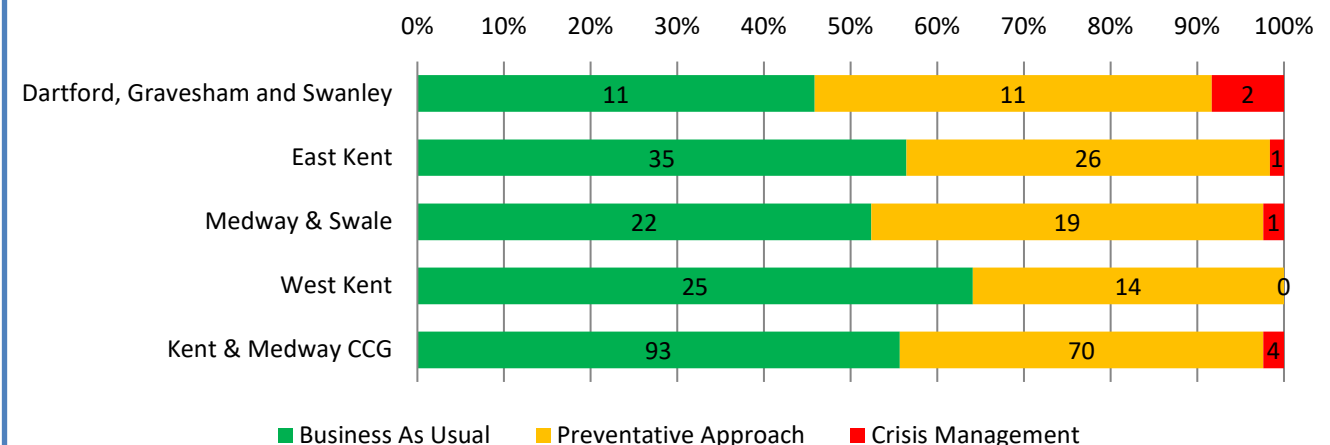


106 (63%) of the practices responding have reported critically low stock of at least 1 item.

Medway ICP are reporting the fewest issues with PPE overall.

Fluid resistant masks and gowns, and disinfectant wipes are in the shortest supply.

Overall Status



4 practices are reporting their status as Crisis Management across Kent and Medway.

IT - 3 practices report remote connectivity insufficient. The main issues are VPN connectivity and Away From My Desk access

PPE - 2 practices gave no PPE information; 1 practice in East Kent is reporting critically low stock of 5 items

Workforce - All 4 practices are reporting at least one staff member shielding/isolating. 3 have stated remote access is inadequate. Support in access to locums has been requested
