Kent and Medway CCG and Chief executives of trusts have written to GP practices "to make clear that referrals continue to be accepted...".

A <u>letter dated 29th April 2020 from Simon Stevens, NHS Chief executive</u>, says that primary care should "Make two-week wait cancer, urgent and routine referrals to secondary care **as normal**…"

In light of this we would greatly appreciate if you could <u>contact this patient directly to let them know that their management will be undertaken by your organisation</u> as was originally planned. This would avoid further unnecessary delays to patient care and minimise further risk to the patient.
