


73 (38%) of the practices responding have reported critically low stock of at least 1 item. This is a marked improvement from last week (63%).

DGS ICP are reporting the fewest issues with PPE overall.

Fluid resistant masks and gowns, and FFP2/3 respirators are in the shortest supply.

One of the main issues highlighted is with maintaining a supply of PPE due to probalems ordering through the NHS supply chain.



0 practices are reporting their status as Crisis Management across Kent and Medway.

A number of practices are still reporting issues with IT and workforce which are inadequate to maintain services effectively.
