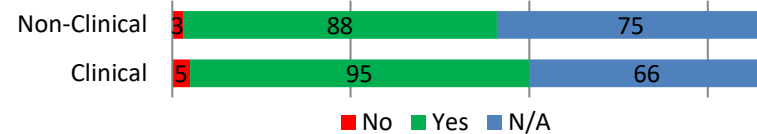

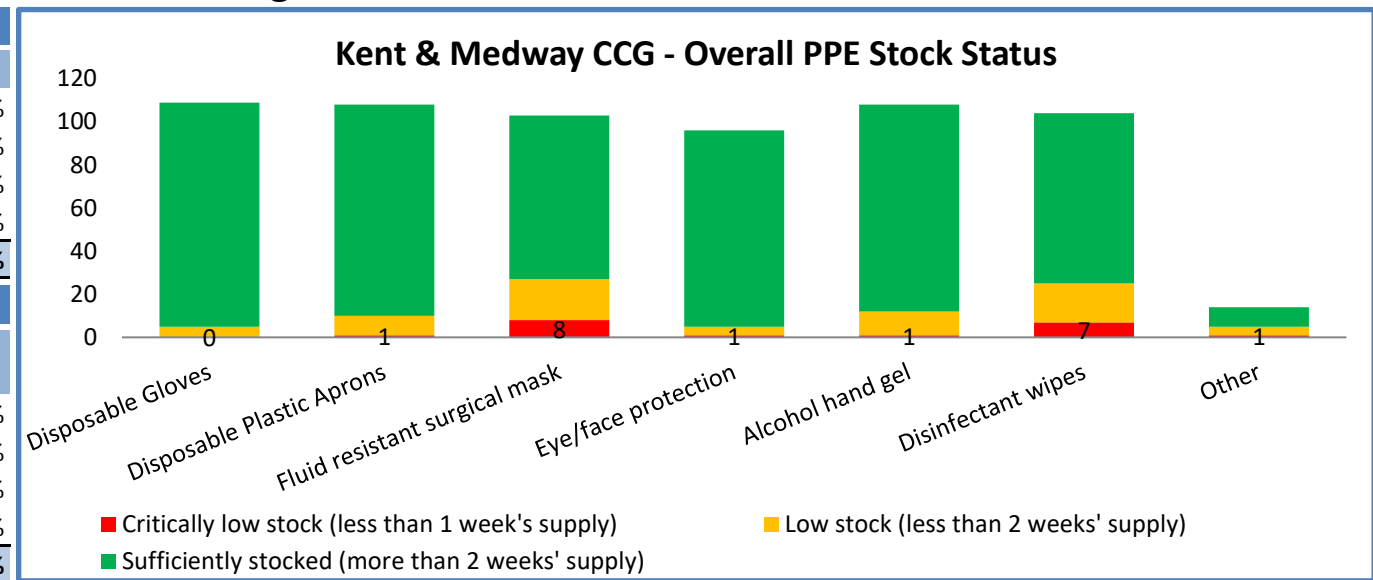
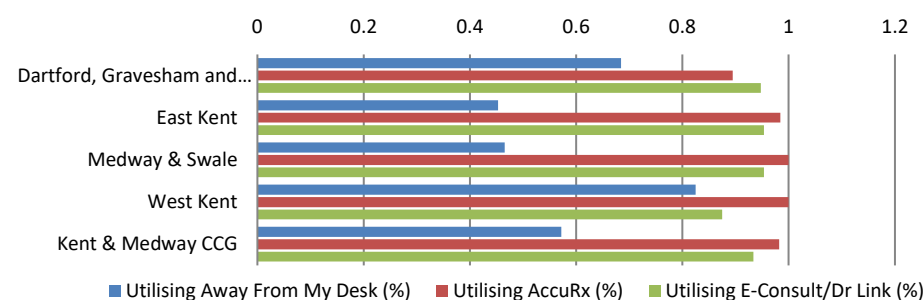

Is the number of isolated/shielded staff who can work remotely adequate to maintain services?



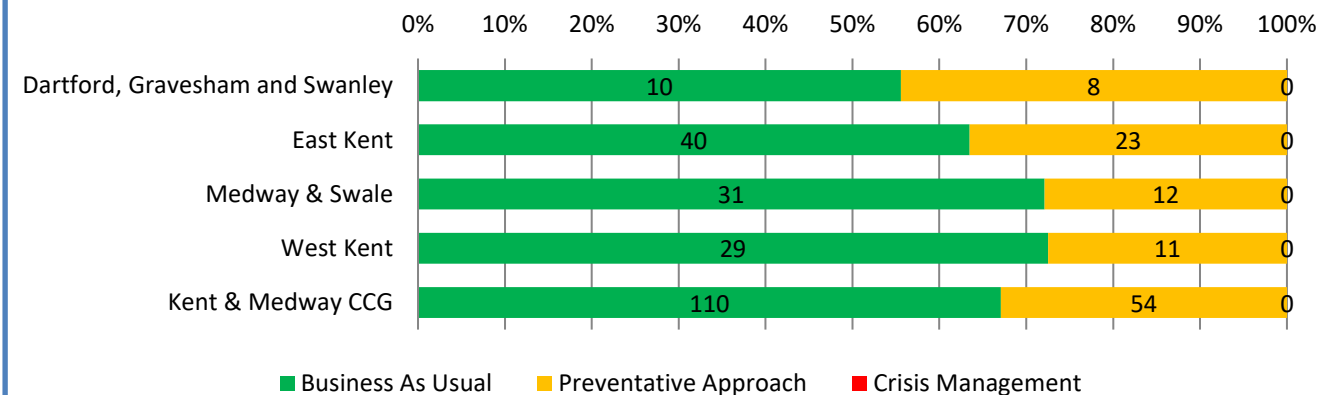
Use of Remote Solutions



15 (7%) of the practices responding have reported critically low stock of at least 1 item. This continues to improve from last week's position.

Dartford, Gravesham and Swanley ICP are reporting the fewest issues with PPE overall. Fluid resistant masks and disinfectant wipes are in the shortest supply. The main issues highlighted were that wipes are difficult to source from suppliers.

Overall Status



No practices are reporting their status as Crisis Management across Kent and Medway.

Practices have flagged the potential for problems once staff begin to take annual leave over the summer, and have also asked for advice regarding shielded patients following recent press.
