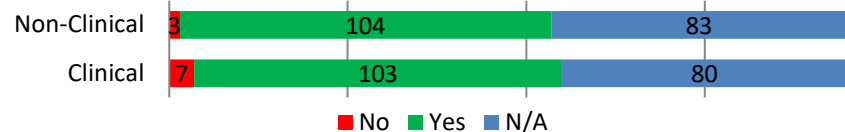

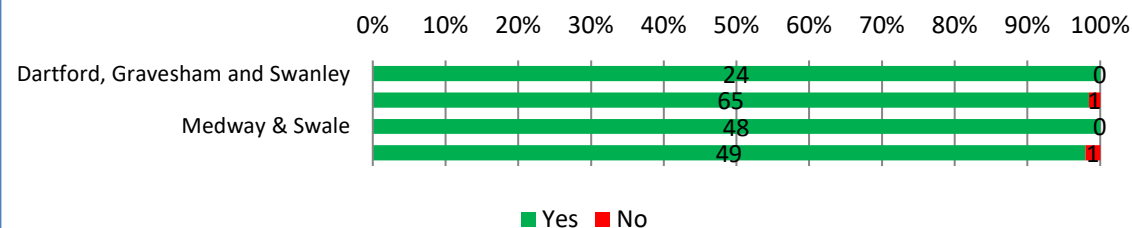

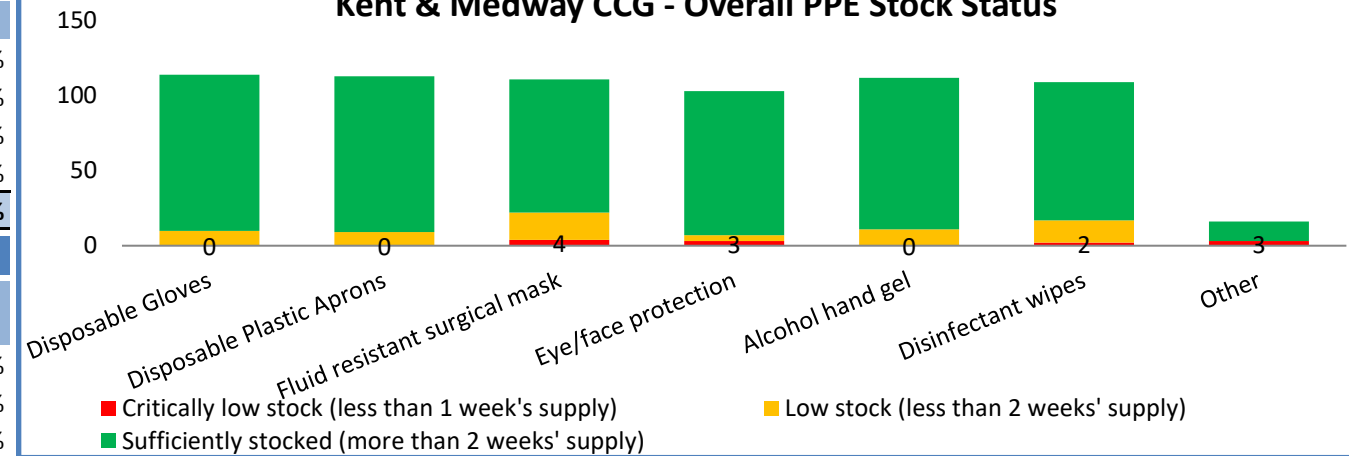
Is the number of isolated/shielded staff who can work remotely adequate to maintain services?



Is the practice able to identify and book women cancelled or deferred for cervical screening due to COVID?



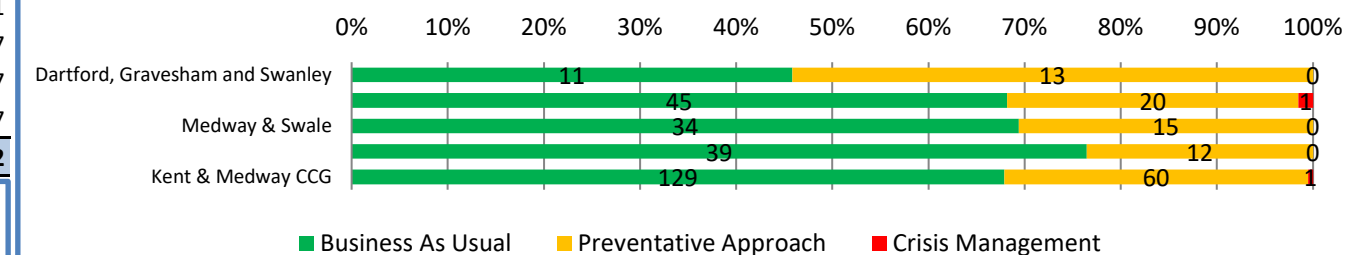
Kent & Medway CCG - Overall PPE Stock Status



11 (6%) of the practices responding have reported critically low stock of at least 1 item.

Fluid resistant masks and disinfectant wipes remain in shortest supply. Practices are also flagging increased costs from providers and potential higher usage with provision of face coverings for patients

Overall Status



One practice in East Kent is reporting their status as Crisis Management.

Practices have asked for more guidance around timescales for hot site closures and the use of Microsoft Teams for meetings. There have also been queries regarding zoning and compliance with updated IPC guidance.
