Clinical advice and support

Updated Covid-19 guidance

Public Health England has published new <u>guidance on infection prevention</u>, including on face coverings in primary care.

Face covering exemptions

The government has set out more <u>detail on face covering exemptions</u>, including <u>exemption cards</u> which can be downloaded from gov.uk. Practices can refer patients to this website so they can download their own material. The government has clarified that there is no need for practices to be involved in this process.

Test results update

NHS Digital has <u>announced</u> that Covid-19 test results are now being automatically sent to GP systems as well as being communicated to patients, giving GPs visibility of which of their patients have had Covid-19 tests and whether they have tested positive or negative for the virus.

Covid-19 Patient Notification System (CPNS)

Further changes have been introduced this week to the CPNS. This will mean the following:

- For patient notifications where:
 - o patients who have tested positive
 - and the difference between the Date of Death and Date of Result is greater than 28 days
- Then:
 - The field Covid cited on Part 1 Part 2 of the Death Certificate needs to be complete
 - If the answer is Yes the record can be submitted
 - o If the answer is No, the record cannot be record.

You cannot input a record with a positive swab over 28 days unless it is also cited on the death certificate.

Infection prevention

Type IIR face masks from Cardinal Health – destroy affected lots

The Medicines and Healthcare products Regulation Authority (MHRA) <u>issued</u> an alert on Monday to all NHS and social care providers, asking organisations to destroy affected lots of the type IIR face masks from Cardinal Health. This must be completed by 3 August 2020. If you are in shortage, you are advised to contact your local resilience forum in the first instance, who may be able to assist you or advise you to <u>contact the National Supply Distribution Response</u>.
