Re-enter NHSMail passwords

NHSMail users will be asked to re-enter email passwords on non-mobile devices from Wednesday 5 August. This follows a security update on NHSMail the day before.

Practice Manager/IT Leads will also need to re-enter the NHSMail password on applications, like Docman etc, that are linked to NHSMail accounts for sending emails.

The change is not expected to affect mobile device users or those that access their email via Outlook Web Access (via web browser). More details are <u>in this alert.</u>
