National flu immunisation programme 2020/21

The expected <u>second letter</u> has been published setting out the new groups which are eligible for the flu vaccination programme this autumn, and the actions that commissioners and providers of the flu vaccine programme should take to prepare. We will include further information about how this will be implemented in Kent and Medway as soon as possible.

The Care Quality Commission has also <u>provided guidance</u> about the key things to consider about your registration with them in the context of this year's flu vaccination arrangements.

And for those who have not already ordered materials for the Health and Social Care Worker flu vaccination campaign, these will be available, if needed, on the PHE Campaign Resource Centre <u>Health and Social Care Workers Flu Immunisation</u> from 7 August.

Zoning guidance

This zoning guidance has been refreshed to support you in your own assessment of your facilities to make sure you can care for patients in an environment which is safe and meets the Care Quality Commission's standards of expectations.

The aim of this guidance is to make sure the facilities meet minimum requirements so that the safety of patients and staff are maintained, and facilities can be zoned so that patients with symptoms of Covid-19 can be consulted to minimize the risk of the spread of infection.

EMIS using practices - new electronic notifications for the urgent supply of medicines

You will soon be able to receive electronic notifications from pharmacies about the urgent supply of medicines made as part of the NHS Community Pharmacist
Consultation Service (CPCS). This will inform you that a patient registered with

your practice has received an urgent supply of medicine from a community pharmacy.

EMIS Web practices will have the new functionality enabled this month. EMIS will inform you of your specific switch on date. The notifications arrive as a workflow task within the EMIS Web system, prompting you to add the information to a patient's record.

Please note, if you use a third-party product, such as Docman, for your patient document management you will need to <u>configure your Document Management</u> <u>task settings in Workflow Manager</u>.

Covid privacy notice

We have been notified by NHSX that the Control of Patient Information (COPI) notice has been extended to the end of March 2021. Please update your privacy notices to reflect this change with the information below:

Full medical records access

Here is a guide to full medical records access using 'GP online'.

We realise that due to Covid-19 patients are unable to visit the practice to provide identity documents for full medical records access, however, patients can register for GP online services virtually and can be vouched for by the practice for other online services, taking in documents when it is safe to do so to use the full range of services.

It is, however, a good time, now that full medical records access is available, to create a culture of thinking about what should be redacted from patient view at the time data is entered into the patient records to reduce the risk of patients seeing 'third party' data or 'harmful information'. Please use the <u>prospective</u> records access practice guidance that shows how to use the redaction tool within Emis and Systmone. Remember to record this process in your records management policy.
