

NHS England South (South East) Position Statement on Influenza Vaccine for 2018/19 Season – updated 5th February 2018 following issue of NHSE letter

Commissioning Position

- The advice from NHSE national team should be taken into account when placing orders for flu vaccines
- General Practice and Community Pharmacies should offer quadrivalent influenza vaccine to eligible patients in at risk groups under the age of 65.
- General Practice and Community Pharmacies should offer the adjuvanted trivalent vaccine (Fluad®) to patients aged 65 and over
- The prescribing of TIV vaccines for any cohort is **not advised** for patients registered with a GP in NHS England South (South East) or those patients resident in Kent, Surrey, Sussex but not currently registered with a GP.
- Prescribing of quadrivalent influenza vaccine is **not advised** for use in patients aged 65 and over registered with a GP in NHS England South (South East) or those patients resident in Kent, Surrey, Sussex but not currently registered with a GP.

Financial Implications

 National funding is now available for aTIV vaccines for those aged 65 and over and for QIV vaccines for those aged under 65 in at risk groups for the 2018/19 season and claims should be made in the usual way
